Description:	The imagined setting for this task is a travel agency. The role of one of the informants is that of a staff member at the travel agency, while the other takes over the role of a customer who wishes to go on holiday but does not know yet where to go to. The staff member is asked to suggest two different destinations to the customer by describing/advertising these places. Afterwards the customer is asked to explain briefly which of the destinations she/he prefers and why. The two destinations, predefined by the elicitation material, are a combination of one capital city and a more general place and vary across the different sessions.
