



## Task 5: City Map



Category:	Route description
Main target:	Informant A
Description:	<p>Based on a map provided, one of the informants has to describe a walk through the city and to name several landmarks. The informant serving as the information giver has a route marked on her/his map as well as several landmarks. For the information follower a map is provided on paper which has a numbered list of the same landmarks on the side of the map but no route. Taking off from the starting point marked on both maps the information giver's task is to describe the route displayed on the map. Whenever a landmark is passed along the route, the information giver is asked to tell the information follower what it is and where exactly it is located. The latter is supposed to follow the route descriptions and note on her/his map where the landmarks are to be found.</p> <p>The maps for information followers are provided on paper. Each map shows a city grid with a river and a starting point (red arrow). The maps are labeled with numbered lists of landmarks in different languages: English, Greek, and German. The landmarks include Information, Camp site, Deaf Theatre, Pharmacy, Deaf Club, Café, Cinema, Post Office, Taxi, and Hotel.</p>
