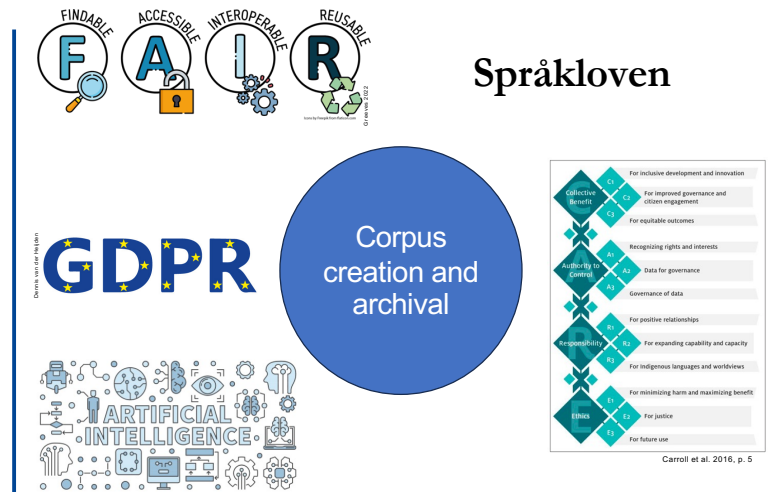


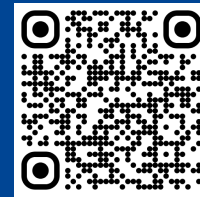
# The Community and Ethics Shaping the Norwegian Sign Language Corpus

## INTRODUCTION TO THE CORPUS

- Data collection: **2015 – 2024**
- **109 signers**, who vary in age, region, gender, socioeconomic, and educational backgrounds
- **60 hours** of recorded interactions: dyad, triad, and multiparty elicited and semi-spontaneous interactions, meetings, presentations
- **Video recordings are published in CLARINO**, the Norwegian branch of CLARIN (a European digital infrastructure for language resources) (see QR code)

## ISSUES

- Respecting signers' **personal data**
- Creating long-term **language resources** that the deaf community can access
- **Facilitating research** on this under-described language
- **Limiting harm and exploitation** by non-aligned technology projects

## DISCUSSION

- Consent and re-consent stipulations: multiple options governing data re-use and sharing
- Two licenses applied to the data.
- Video-recordings, summarized background information of signers, and a selection of elicitation and other supplementary materials (copy of consent forms, background questionnaires, etc.) are published online.
- Full background information on the signers, video-data with consent restrictions, as well as the Corpus annotations files are not published online– but may be available by contacting the Corpus manager.
